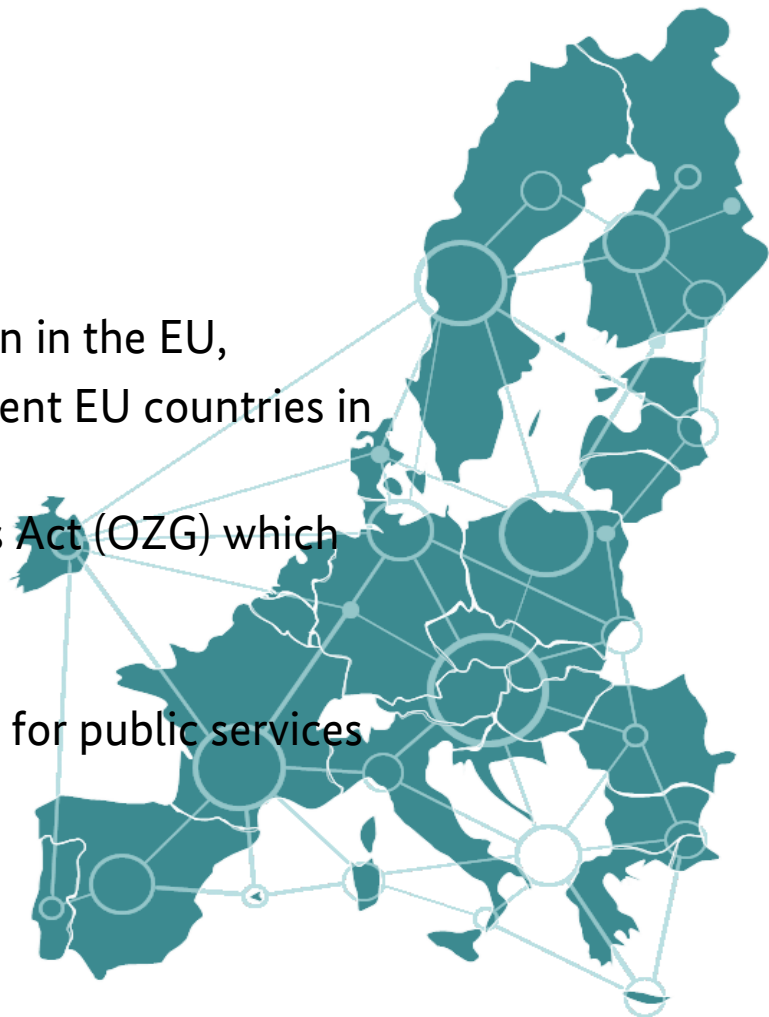

Introduction

The single digital gateway

- is a **single point of access** to public administration in the EU,
- reduces online barriers between citizens of different EU countries in order to establish a **digital single market** and
- goes hand in hand with Germany's Online Access Act (OZG) which aims to **user-friendliness, quality and adequacy**

→ “Your Europe” provides a common user interface for public services offered by all the EU member states.



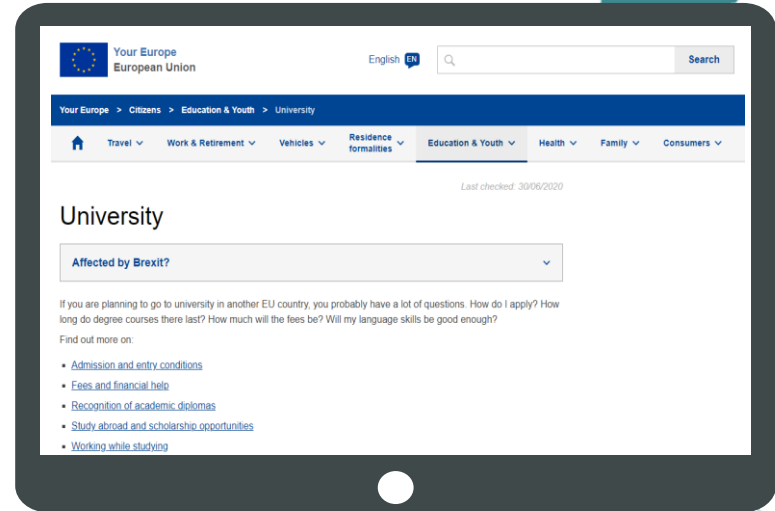
Aims

- to reduce administrative barriers for citizens and businesses
 - to make it easier for them to participate in the EU's internal market
 - to give access to **information, procedures and assistance services** available in all the official EU languages
 - to increase the number of administrative procedures can be performed online
- guiding citizens and companies to information on national and EU rules, rights and procedures

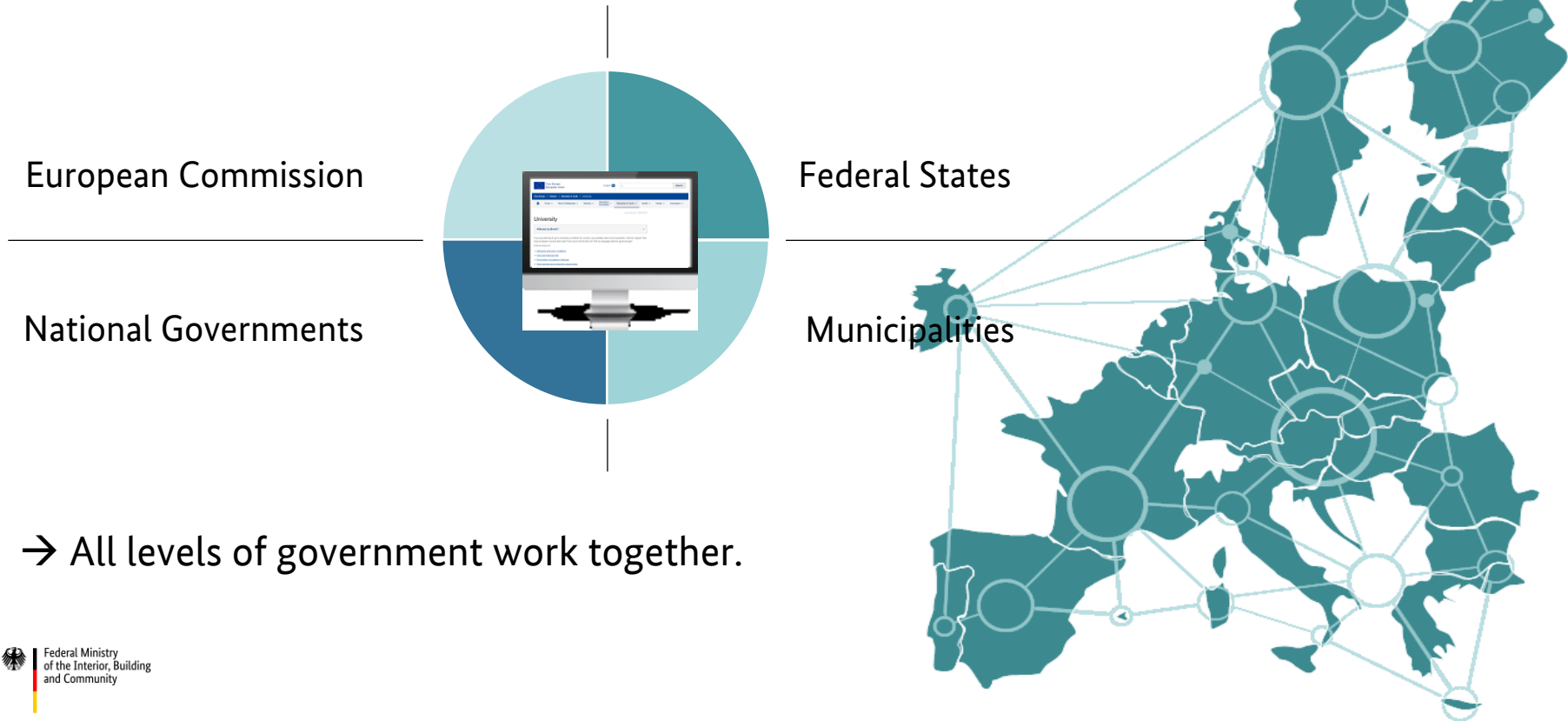

II. Procedures

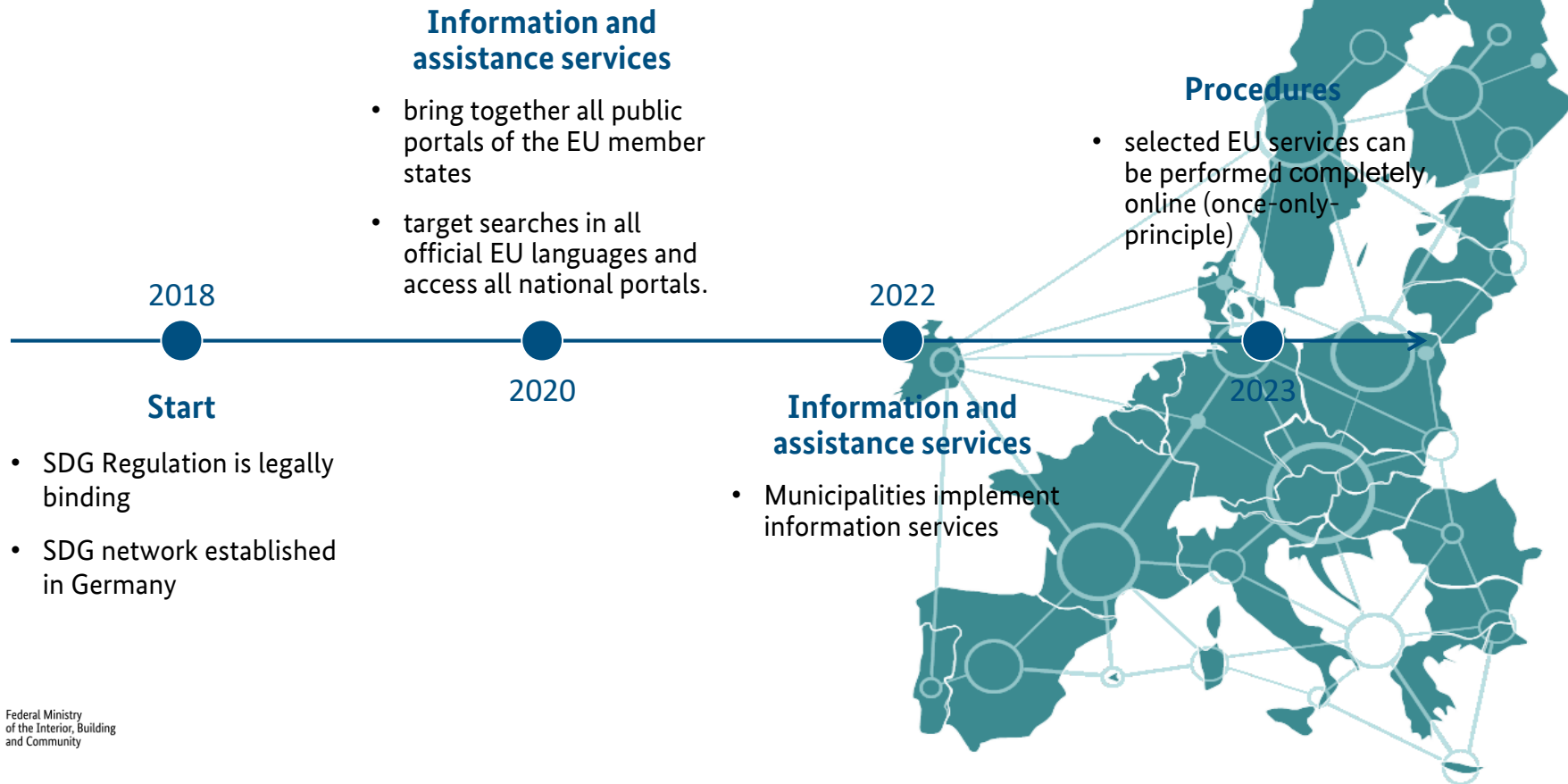
- 21 most frequently used procedures
