Its core activities include production and dissemination of legal and general publications in a variety of paper and electronic formats, managing a range of websites



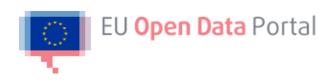

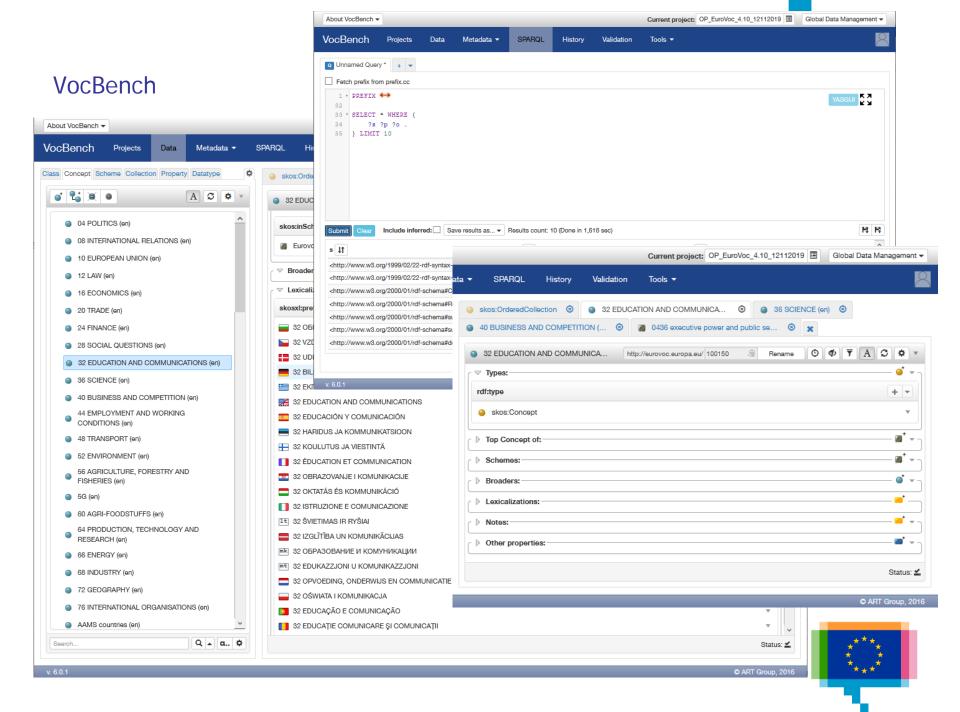
